- Earliest start of reg closure since 1992
- 110 days in reg closure, longest period ever?
- 16 new max ERCs (June 20, June 23-July 7)

 (at Blue Canyon previous 20 yr high was 114)

 IC = probability that a firebrand landing on a receptive fuel will cause a fire requiring suppression action (at or near record highs at both BC and YP)

Blue Canyon RAWS is 3 miles WNW of Salisbury Jct and 8 miles SW of Baker City (20 yrs data) Yellow Pine RAWS is 8 miles NW of Unity (15 years data)




SPA Helicopter – Significant Event

On July 20th, 1PT was ordered for bucket work on the Blue Creek Fire on WDNR protection, nine miles east of Walla Walla, WA. While at a tight dip site, 1PT lost power to the main rotor. While attempting to land, the main rotor blades struck a tree causing the helicopter to tip over on its side. The pilot was


uninjured and walked away. Soon after, the helicopter was overtaken by the fire resulting in the complete loss of the aircraft.
